Footnotes

JAYBIRD'S MIRACLE was rated in hand gaining a position behind foes in the second flight, angled to the rail racing through the backstretch, made steady progress along the inside nearing upper stretch to gain striking distance, then shifted out three wide racing through the lane while producing a steady late response to narrowly edge IRVING RULES in time under pressure. The latter was urged to the lead along the inside soon after the break, held sway on a clear margin through the turn, then past midstretch but just failed to contain the winner. SON OF TIGER tracked the pacesetter inside foes in the second flight under some rating racing into the turn, shifted outside the leader to challenge entering upper stretch but finished evenly in late stages when failing to match the top pair. CHIEF BEAR, reserved between foes well off the second flight early, angled to the rail entering the turn and made steady progress inside foes to the end to improve his placing. SPANISH BARON tracked off the second flight between foes in early stages, angled out five wide entering upper stretch while gaining some position but had no final bid. SERENGETI TOUR tracked off the the second flight unhurried while shifting off the inside, made some progress to gain contention racing four wide through the turn but flattened out in upper stretch. QUIET REVOLUTION settled near the inside in the opening half, angled out six wide racing into the stretch to gain some position but made no impact. INVISIBLE STAR settled into stride while angling to the inside but never mounted a serious challenge. TEXAS HEDGE never seriously menaced. CREOLE'S AFFAIR was a brief factor in the second flight but

steadily retreated after a half. DRUMBLARE tracked the pacesetter three deep in the second flight early, continued between foes into the turn but emptied out when lacking any further response after six furlongs.
