Footnotes

LATENT RUSH took up a position just off and outside the first flight racing into the turn, shifted four wide in upper stretch, produced a solid late response leaving the furlong marker to wrest command leaving the sixteenth marker, then kicked clear late under some right handed encouragement. WINDY CITY RICHIE gained terms with a rival on the pace attending that foe's tempo, pressed the issue racing into upper stretch to gain the advantage, couldn't fend off the winner's bid but just held place honors. LITTLE KICK settled into stride along the rail, came around a tiring foe entering upper stretch and continued willingly inside foes racing in the stretch while just missing for second. THUNDER HARBOR was roused to gain a position just off the first flight along the inside racing into the turn, shifted out to bid three deep between foes in upper stretch but was outkicked. SMITTY settled outside foes in the opening stages, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch but had no closing bid. ROCKED, roused to secure the lead along the inside from the break, set the pace along the rail to upper stretch and gave out.
