Footnotes

JESS N NAT bobbed at the start but was quickly righted, then urged to secure the lead along the inside, dictated the pace on a narrow margin through the turn, then was roused in upper stretch to extend her advantage. BELLAMAYA tracked the pace between foes in second flight early, was urged to prompt the leader nearing upper stretch but couldn't gain even terms with that foe while proving best of the others. GALETOIRE raced between foes in second flight early, worked her way to the inside on the bend, shifted out three deep in upper stretch and finished evenly in late stages while earning a share. TECNICA, caught four wide racing into the turn while urged to gain position in second flight, steadily faded in the drive. CARLI'S SONG broke a step slowly, raced well off the inside to upper stretch but never gained contention. AULT STREET, slow to gather stride, was guided to the inside while being urged to advance racing into the stretch but lacked the needed late response. ABUNDANT MIZ was held up just off the leaders avoiding close quarters along the rail racing into the bend and soon retreated from contention.
