THREE HOUR NAP raced near the middle of the field, came six wide into the stretch, rallied through the lane and was along in time. SALEM SCHOOL ROAD raced close up four wide, took the lead between calls in deep stretch and just failed to last. GENERAL CHARLEY was part of the pace battle three wide and lacked a winning bid. EXCEPTIONAL RIDE raced close up between horses and weakened a bit. COME ON CHAS lacked speed and improved his position. UNLEASHED STORM raced five wide near the middle of the field and was not a factor. TEPEXPAN saved ground but tired. FLYING CHANCE lacked speed and showed little. JAZZY GALLOP was bumped at the start and was always outrun. TOAST THE GHOST set the pace from the inside while pressed and tired. KID GRINDSTONE lugged in at the start and was outrun. BIGBOYBDANCING was never close.
