SUAVE vied for the lead off the rail and drew off in the stretch in handy fashion. COURTHOUSE raced close up off the rail and rallied for the place while no danger to the winner. STEP RIGHT IN raced close up three wide and rallied closer in the stretch but lacked a winning bid. APT TO BE was bumped at the start, raced near the middle of the field and improved his position. FIERY DIABLO raced close up inside and weakened. WIN ME OVER lacked speed and improved his position. MONKEY HILL stumbled at the start and was never a factor. COPING also failed to reach contention. WILD TALE raced near the middle of the field and gave way. AJEDREZ (ARG) saved ground but was outrun. SMOKED EM was also outrun. PRAIRIE KING contested the pace off the rail and gave way.
