BACETTO was off a bit slow, ran down his foes five wide then drew off late. FRANK'S TIME was always close, had a brief lead in the stretch and gamely saved the place. DEPUTY SREVA raced on the rail early, was taken up sharply in the stretch then angled in and was gaining too late. QUITE ACCEPTABLE showed no speed and made a late gain six wide. Z STORM set the pace under a tight hold and tired late in the stretch. DUNSCOMBE was unhurried early, loomed a threat in the turn while wide and gave way. MOMENTARILY raced in second flight inside and stopped and was far back in the stretch.
