Footnotes

WISE GOODBYES broke inwards into the path of WRAPPED IN GOLD, quickly assumed command along the rail, dictated the pace on a narrow margin to upper stretch, then surged clear racing through the stretch while being kept to steady pressure. CANDY PASS chased the pacesetter along the inside racing as part of the second flight and proved best of the others. SURFER ROSA tracked the leaders unhurried while caught five wide in early stages, made some progress three deep on the bend, angled in nearing upper stretch, split foes racing through the stretch and steadily improved her position. BEA'S HARD SIX, brushed at the start, was urged to secure a tracking position just outside the pacesetter, chased that foe into upper stretch and weakened nearing the furlong marker. WRAPPED IN GOLD shied away from a rival at the start while losing position, saved ground to upper stretch and displayed some belated interest. HEAVENS CHEER swerved out just after the start, was righted, then urged to chase the pacesetter three wide into the bend and gave way in upper stretch. BELLAMY LASS never seriously menaced. EPPI'S TIGRESS broke a bit awkwardly while brushing a rival, ducked while under pressure to contend racing four wide between foes in the opening stages, altered course abruptly entering the turn to race between foes just behind the second flight but quickly dropped out.
