Footnotes

VALISE tracked just outside the leaders from out of striking distance in the opening half, advanced three wide racing through the bend to gain terms with the pacesetter in upper stretch, wrested command leaving the furlong marker and went clear under firm encouragement. FOXIE'S BOY broke sharply, dictated the pace near the inside racing into the bend, couldn't fend off the winner but proved best of the others. EVEN RAISE tracked the leaders off the inside, came around foes to race four wide into upper stretch and steadily improved position. TIMELESS FACTS tracked just off the pacesetter racing to the bend, bid between foes after six furlongs but flattened out in upper stretch. DEPUTY SREVA, bumped at the start, was settled off the inside, shifted out four wide and made some mild progress in late stages. OUGHTA BE MINE broke out, bumped DEPUTY SREVA, was collected to track the leaders along the inside to the turn but steadily faded nearing upper stretch. FRANK'S TIME tracked the pace unhurried outside foes in the opening half but never gained contention. SWORD AND SHIELD never seriously menaced.
