THIEF settled into stride along the inside from well out of striking distance in the opening stages, steadily advanced along the rail on the turn gaining contention after a half, shifted out leaving the furlong marker while producing a solid late response and just edged FOXIE'S BOY on the wire under firm encouragement. The latter, a bit rank near the inside in the opening stages when relinquishing the lead to a rival in the opening furlong, shifted out to split foes nearing the half mile marker brushing COLLIDIN, then shifted inwards crossing the path of BEHR FACT entering the turn, set the pace on a clear margin to midstretch, resisted the winner's challenge to the end and just failed to contain that foe. HE'S HOT SAUCE, reserved a bit off the inside from just out of striking distance in the opening stages, advanced to contention shifting out four wide racing through the turn but flattened out in the final quarter. BEHR FACT, urged to the lead outside a rival from the break, was forced inwards a bit by that foe entering the turn, tracked the pacesetter along the inside while being urged to challenge after a half but lacked the needed final response. THE REAL CHAS tracked just off the leaders near the inside in early stages, shifted out racing through the turn but came up empty after a half. COLLIDIN, urged to dispute the pace three deep from the outset, was brushed after the opening quarter by FOXIE'S BOY, chased that rival between foes into the bend and gave way nearing upper stretch. LUCKY MERLOT trailed throughout.
