**Footnotes**

STREET FLYER was guided to the rail in the opening stages securing a position just off the leaders while under some rating, tracked the leaders along the rail to the bend, shifted out leaving the midway point of the turn commencing his challenge, then produced a sustained response racing through the stretch to just collar EN RAPPORT on the wire under brisk right handed encouragement. The latter, off a step behind the leaders, was urged to gain terms with a rival on the pace along the rail, edged away to a clear advantage on the turn, held sway into upper stretch while shifting a bit off the inside and grudgingly resisted the winner to the end. GO POSSE GO settled well off the field in the opening half, came around some tiring foes on the bend, split rivals while angling to the inside entering upper stretch and continued willingly near the rail to late stages to close the gap and gain a share. OH SO LO tracked off the second flight along the inside under some reserve in the opening half, came under pressure to advance on the turn, shifted out nearing upper stretch and continued with a mild bid despite the loss of his rider's whip. LIGHTNING BLUE settled off the second flight outside foes in early stages, raced four wide through the turn and lacked the needed closing bid. RUN BIG BUD RUN broke sharply, prompted the pace outside a rival racing into the bend and gave way after five furlongs. DEAL OF A LIFETIME, forwardly placed between foes tracking the leaders, steadily faded from contention on the turn. MOB BOSS ducked outwards at the start, was quickly righted to briefly chase the leaders four wide on the backstretch but gave way abruptly after a half.
