Footnotes

EASTERN PRECIPICE, urged to secure the lead along the inside racing into the first turn, alternated with a rival on the lead racing through the backstretch while attending the pace in hand, steadily asserted herself on the far turn to gain a clear advantage racing into upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm encouragement. EXPLOSIVE DART, reserved along the rail while well off the leaders in the opening half, made steady progress nearing upper stretch while continuing to save ground, came through some traffic while shifting out in upper stretch, then split foes three deep in late stages to prevail for place honors nearing the wire. PERFECT STRANGER tracked the first flight from within striking distance along the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out three deep midway through the far turn while being urged to challenge, couldn't gain terms with the winner and was outfinished for the place. GOSTOSA, off a bit slowly, was held up off the second flight while angling to the inside in early stages, saved ground throughout and made an effort to improve her position inside foes racing into the stretch. AND HOW, reserved between foes off the second flight in the opening half, couldn't make an impression despite being pressured on the far turn, angled out five wide in upper stretch and steadily faded from contention. HOIST THE COLORS, unhurried racing four wide through the turn while behind the second flight, made some brief progress outside foes entering the far turn, couldn't sustain that effort after six furlongs, then was fanned six wide into the stretch while giving way. ALGONQUIN POSSE broke sharply, angled inwards to prompt the pace outside a rival racing to the backstretch, forced the issue entering the far turn and gave way entering upper stretch when proving no match. BABY POLLY gained a position outside a rival in the second flight racing to the backstretch but dropped out quickly after a half.
