DRAMA KING raced near the middle of the field, angled out and rallied for a late decision. COOL RUSH raced close up three wide but could not finish with the winner. MISTOFFELEES pressed the pace from just outside and took a short lead in the stretch but could not last. KIPPER VILLE raced near the middle of the field and lacked a rally. MAGIC JADE lacked speed then rallied up the rail in the stretch but flattened out. QUAPAW CHARLIE was bumped at the start, lacked speed and passed tired rivals. WITH DISTINCTION raced close up outside and dropped back steadily. QUAD BYPASS was always outrun. LITTLEBITAGLITTER set the pace from the rail while pressed and tired. RAMPANT trailed throughout.
