Footnotes

BREAKING NEWS had steady advance, angled in during the stretch run, battled late and bested foe at the wire. MORE THAN ABLE swung wide in the second turn, battled late but was outnodded at the wire. MOSCOW ADVENTURE raced mid-pack early, lacked room in the second turn, had a brief lead in the stretch and weakened. SNAKE RIVER CANYON chased the pace off the rail, drew even in the lane but failed to sustain the bid. SWIFT PINE had no speed, made a bid while wide in the second turn but was not good enough. HEZA FLAMER had no speed and improved position. BACK ALLEY TALES had a rail trip and failed to menace. STEPS SILVER HALO raced evenly and lacked a late response. ERNEST DREAM broke sharply, took the lead early but faltered in the lane. SILVER SALUTE raced wide, loomed a threat, but stopped in the second turn. ESLA MAMBO set the first pace, was used up then stopped inside. RACE RUN IN LANE 3, 6 FEET OUT.
