Footnotes

PIRATES VOW broke readily, dictated the pace in hand along the rail racing into the bend, forged clear nearing upper stretch and steadily widened his advantage under pressure. SPECTACULAR KID attended the pace between foes from the outset, lost some position to the leader entering the bend, but responded well enough to secure second from between foes nearing upper stretch to prove second best. APPLESOLUTELY WILD was settled between foes in the opening quarter, swung four wide racing into upper stretch and continued with a mild bid while earning a share. GENTLEMAN JACKSON came under pressure early chasing the leaders along the inside, saved ground to upper stretch and finished evenly along the rail. WAKEUPBRANDON, forwardly placed three wide between foes from the outset, pressed the issue in that path into the turn, then faded nearing upper stretch. WEKIVA WACHEE was settled outside foes in the opening stages and never mounted a serious challenge. SABER, urged to contend four wide in the opening stages, pressed in that path racing into the turn and gave way. BEWARE THE TIGER was outpaced early.
