Footnotes

APPLE MARTINI, held up outside a rival in second flight racing to the backstretch, commenced a steady advance on the far turn to close the gap on the pacesetter nearing upper stretch, took over from that foe with a sixteenth to go and prevailed under firm right handed encouragement. SWEET RELISH, pulling her way along racing into the first turn, opened a commanding margin racing into the far turn but failed to sustain her momentum through the last furlong. EMBERS GLOWING dwelt at the start, was settled along the inside, gradually gained terms with the second flight on the far turn, angled out three deep entering upper stretch and continued well enough to earn a share. ROMIN ROBIN, a bit rank under restraint racing as part of the second flight along the inside to the backstretch, made a brief advance in tandem with the eventual winner racing through the far turn but lacked the needed final bid. GOLDILOX was settled off the inside just off the second flight racing to the backstretch, made a brief bid racing through the far turn but had no final response while being taken in hand in late stages.
