Footnotes

ITZACOLDCASE angled inwards to gain terms with a rival on the lead, attended that foe's pace in hand racing into the turn, came under pressure in upper stretch to force the issue, edged forward to a narrow advantage leaving the furlong marker and held her rivals safe on a narrow margin to the end under firm right handed prompting. ALICE'S SMART, reserved off the second flight along the rail in the opening stages, saved ground to upper stretch, shifted out five wide approaching the furlong marker and was going well late. HOLIDAY IN DIXIE tracked just off the first flight three deep in the opening stages, made steady progress in that path on the turn to challenge entering upper stretch, then continued willingly between foes while shifting inwards a bit in late stages to prevail for a share. MISSJEANLOUISE pulled her way to the lead along the inside soon after the break, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing into the bend, disputed the lead racing into upper stretch but was outfinished. GAMBLER FIVE broke slowly, settled into stride outside a rival, shifted out entering the turn, advanced four wide on the bend to gain striking distance after a half but flattened out in late stages. LICA'S BLUFF tracked the leaders as part of the second flight along the inside, saved ground on the turn and steadily faded in the drive. ONE STAR gained a position between foes in the second flight racing to the turn but came up empty after a half.
