KNIGHT AFTER NIGHT was rated off the first flight along the inside racing through the first turn, shifted out three deep on the backstretch while tracking the leaders from within striking distance while under some reserve, steadily advanced in that path entering the far turn to challenge for command nearing upper stretch and edged clear late under firm prompting. EL MOSCO broke slowly, settled into stride along the inside for five furlongs, gathered momentum while angling out four wide racing into upper stretch and continued with a steady effort to prevail for second. BE BRAVE, bumped by C. C. BANJO, then held up out of tight quarters at the start, was guided to the rail while pulling a bit racing behind the second flight in the opening half, made steady progress to gain contention along the rail racing into the far turn, shifted out to split foes entering the second bend challenging for command, led between calls on the far turn but couldn't match the winner's bid and lost second in late stages. EIGHT GAUGE, reserved between foes off the second flight in the opening half, angled to the inside entering the far turn, made some progress to gain some position while racing in close quarters on the second bend, shifted out entering upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. BOWMANS CASTLE, urged to secure a position outside a rival in the second flight racing to the backstretch, emptied out abruptly entering the far turn. FRANKLIN COUNTY, caught a bit wide in the opening stages, tracked the pace outside foes off the second flight,

shifted out five wide racing through the backstretch but never mounted a serious challenge. C. C. BANJO broke outwards bumping a rival, was urged to the lead from between foes then angled to the inside entering the backstretch, disputed the lead inside foes racing into the second turn and emptied out nearing the quarter mile marker. BARANIT, caught a bit wide racing into the first turn while being prompted to secure terms with several rivals in the first flight, pressed the pace three wide for five furlongs and emptied out entering the far turn. ASIAN SENSATION, forwardly placed along the inside in early stages, switched out entering the backstretch to race between foes attending the pace but gave way abruptly after a half.
