LADY LANG raced close up four wide, rallied to the lead between calls in deep stretch and was all out to last. UNAFFORDABLE raced off the rail near the middle of the field, rallied in the stretch and just missed. QUICK ALERT set the pace from off the rail while pressed, opened daylight in the stretch then could not hold off the top two. BAILAR lacked speed and gained belatedly. DWENDI raced close up inside and weakened. GRAB THE BUCK pressed the pace from the inside and tired. CHILLING EFFECT raced close up off the rail and gave way. MS. MARY H was always outrun. ALYGREY raced near the middle of the field and gave way. FREEWAY DANCER was outrun.
