THATS WHATSHESAID waited for room in the turn, slipped through at the top of the lane, lugged out badly but got up late. SWEET LEMON CHELLO vied for the lead inside, drew off in the lane but was caught late. CYBER OUTLAW had no speed then rallied up the rail and was gaining late. CUPID'S BEST had a wide trip, drew even at the top of the stretch but failed to sustain bid. GROOM CHASER was slow early then had a mild rally while widest in the stretch. LAST STOP was always close between horses, came in during the stretch run and tired. SALTY OUTLAW raced evenly and failed to menace. JOHN D'S VALENTINE vied for the lead between horses, was used up and dropped back. RUN MAMA BEARE RUN was through early and no factor. INSCRIPT vied for the lead between horses, was taken up sharply and stopped in the stretch.
