SMOKE N ASPHALT, on terms with the pacesetter from the outset, attended that rival's tempo while in hand racing to the bend, steadily advanced to challenge that foe nearing upper stretch, continued in an extended skirmish past the furlong marker and edged forward late under brisk handling. TIMES UP was urged to the lead along the inside, set the pace into upper stretch, then grudgingly resisted the winner's challenge to late stages. WINDY CITY LEAL was settled off the inside in the opening stages, swung out four wide nearing upper stretch commencing his advance, then shifted inwards in late stages while producing his best stride late to earn a share. BRISTOL BOY, reserved off the inside in the opening stages, split foes entering upper stretch while exchanging some contact with SOUTHERN MUDD, continued with interest between foes and was just outfinished for a share. BURNING CRUSADE tracked just off the leaders outside foes in the opening stages, made a steady advance to challenge three wide racing through the turn but flattened out leaving midstretch. SOUTHERN MUDD tracked the pace between foes in second flight, angled inwards on the bend, shifted out exchanging contact with BRISTOL BOY in upper stretch and steadily faded from contention. SHARP ROMA, between foes in second flight in the opening quarter, was held up out of tight quarters nearing the bend, shifted three wide on the turn and steadily retreated nearing upper stretch. DAY OF TRUTH angled in to track just off the first flight racing to the turn but gave way nearing upper stretch.
