THE GREEN COUGAR raced off the second flight while angling to the inside in the opening stages, shifted out on the turn while moving to split foes three deep racing into upper stretch, then produced a solid late response to reel in the leader in time to prevail under firm encouragement. LOOKIN AT COUNTRY was urged clear of the field soon after the break, dictated the pace on an open margin to upper stretch but couldn't contain the winner's late bid. SUN RED tracked the pacesetter between foes in the second flight and continued evenly into the stretch to prevail for a share. EVEN FEVER tracked the pace inside rivals in the second flight and continued evenly into the lane. LAST NOUNCER, held up outside foes avoiding traffic at the start, shifted out six wide racing into the stretch while making an effort to improve position. SMARTY BOY, crowded between foes at the start, was urged to gain a contending position four wide racing into the turn but lacked the needed late kick. LONGEVITY, bumped at the start, was caught five wide racing into the turn while making brief bid but flattened out racing into upper stretch. FISHING LINE broke outwards bumping SMARTY BOY, was righted to briefly pursue the pacesetter three deep between foes but retreated early.
