ZAVILL was settled into stride while angling to the rail in the opening stages, gradually gathered momentum splitting foes just off the inside racing through the bend, came inside the pacesetter to challenge for command racing into upper stretch and moved forward late under right handed encouragement. COMMANDO KAT was rated stalking just off the first flight while shifting a bit off the rail racing through the backstretch, inherited the lead nearing upper stretch while angling inside, shifted wide racing through upper stretch and yielded to the winner late. ONE FOR BISCUIT tracked the pace between foes in the second flight racing to the turn and continued evenly three deep between foes entering the stretch while continuing well enough to earn a share. BEWARE THE TIGER moved to the fore in the opening stages while angling nearer to the inside dictating the pace on a narrow margin, continued to dispute the issue inside a rival while drifting well off the rail nearing upper stretch and gave way entering the lane. KID CHIC joined a rival on the pace attending the tempo in the opening stages, moved to dispute the issue while being carried wide nearing the quarter mile marker and soon gave way. GRAND SILVER was never a factor. TEXAS HEDGE dropped out early. PERFECT CASTING, caught in tight quarters at the start, tracked the leaders in second flight along the rail racing into the bend but had no closing response.
