CAJUN PRIZE was void of speed then circled seven wide on the turn then made a steady advance to get up in time. VAQUERO rated in the second flight and saved ground, angled out then rallied late. CLASSIC EMPIRE showed no speed and saved ground, was asked between horses and made a late rally. TURNPIKE TOMMY stalked the pace, made a four wide bid on the turn but it was not enough. CIELO CLASSIC stumbled at the start then was rushed up and set the pace, led and faded in the lane. GRAND PLAY rated in the second flight, was boxed in on the turn then altered course and rallied too late. PRAY TELL got off slowly then was asked while five wide on the turn and showed some run late. MEMORIAL MANIAC got bumped at the start and dropped back then passed tiring rivals. NEAR PERFECT showed no speed and had a rail trip, was asked but made no rally. STORMING VOW wouldn't load into the gate, raced close up and chased the pace but tired. DOUBLE SILVER raced close up while six wide into the first turn then dropped back and was no factor.
