LAYTHATPISTOLDOWN broke sharply, settled in along the rail, angled out to take the lead and drew clear. TENS WILD made a steady advance, made a bid in the stretch but couldn't get to the winner and was second best. WALK THE WALK was unhurried early then rallied for the show honors. LAKOTA WOLF raced mid pack early, checked hard heading for home but was gaining late. TALE OF THE KITTEN broke in the air, trailed early, veered out sharply in the turn and rallied while wide. CHAS THE MAN settled in, moved to the leader on the turn inside, steadied then faded in the lane. SHELLYS WILD had no speed, checked hard in the second turn and improved position. RYAN'S REX had no early speed, veered out sharply in the turn and was wide in the stretch. ROYAL CANDIDATE took the lead early, drew off on the backstretch then faltered in the stretch. BADGER BAY had good early speed, was tiring, checked in the turn and dropped back. GAMES BEGIN unhurried early, was making move in the second turn, clipped heels and took up sharply to avoid a fall. THERE WAS A GENERAL STEWARD'S INQUIRY INTO THE RACE BUT NO FURTHER ACTION WAS TAKEN.
