KITTY COMEDY raced close up between foes, rallied to the lead on the turn and drew off under moderate urging. PLUSH lacked speed while off the rail, angled out four wide for the drive and rallied for the place while no danger to the winner. LADY DEALER raced near the middle of the field while off the rail and rallied in the stretch but lacked a winning bid. NATBOO raced close up inside and weakened. SHERRY'S DUSTYROSE was never a factor. SMILIN' BABY lacked speed and showed little. TO GOOD TO LOVE pressed the pace just outside and tired. ALI OOP GENI set the pace from the inside while pressed, stopped after a half and was eased in the stretch.
