SHESA SPELLBINDER was fractious behind the gate and passed tired ones in the drive. SONORA'S MOON also passed tired rivals. PAIGES PEBBLE lacked speed and showed little. Z Z JABER JAWS was never a factor. RAVALLI GIRL raced near the middle of the field and gave way. ASTROS CHOICE dropped back steadily.
