COWBOY STUFF made the front early, set the pace on a clear lead while kept away from the rail, and was not menaced in the run to the wire while kept to his task. PASS RUSH stalked the pace of the winner from well off the rail, was asked to go after the top one in the drive and gained some ground but was not a match. A. P. FIVE HUNDRED raced close up inside then had no winning bid when asked for his best. WINDWARD PASSAGE raced near the middle of the field while just outside and failed to rally. COLORFUL TOUR lacked speed and mad a mild run in the stretch but never threatened. RESIDENT ROGUE lacked speed then passed beaten rivals late. SHARP GOLD raced near the middle of the field while well off the rail and was never a factor. RAINY PARADE was always outrun. THUNDERPUMPER saved ground near the middle of the field but dropped back steadily.
