HEAT OF THE NIGHT (SAF) raced in the second flight, waited for room in the turn, split horses and gamely held off foes. WAGON ROAD was bumped at the start, stalked the pace off the rail, took the late lead and weakened. LACER was bumped at the start, found his best stride late five wide. DRIVINGMAXANDMITZI raced in the second flight, loomed a threat but was not good enough. EL INDY was bumped at the start, rallied too late then steadied when there was no room. HOME MINISTER raced evenly inside and had no rally.. CRESSON (GB) steadied early and was no threat. CAJOLE was brushed at the start and failed to menace. WHO LET THE CAT IN set the pace, was used up and stopped. RACE RUN IN LANE 1.
