LEWIS MICHAEL was well handled, stalked the pace, edged to lead on the second turn then drew off when asked. MUSTANFAR was never far back three wide, angled inside in the stretch and was second best. A. P. ARROW had no early speed, then closed the gap late inside. THRONG set a pressured pace, weakened in the upper stretch and drifted a bit late. HIGH BLUES was void of early speed and raced wide throughout. SAVE BIG MONEY saved ground and failed to menace. MINISTER'S JOY was no factor and trailed throughout.
