CARL'S C NOTE was settled into stride in last along the inside in the opening stages, steadily drew into contention shifting a bit off the inside racing through the turn, angled out nearing upper stretch to split foes three deep, shifted outside foes racing through the stretch but continued with solid late response to wrest command and draw clear late under firm encouragement. TRIPLE OVERTIME tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight from just out of striking distance, angled four wide leaving the midway point of the bend while moving to contention, continued in that path while moving to gain a clear advantage between calls leaving midstretch but proved no match when confronted by the winner. CHIEF WANDO tracked the leaders along the inside in second flight, saved ground on the bend, briefly awaited an opening nearing upper stretch, shifted out to split foes challenging for command in upper stretch but was outkicked by the top pair. SHOTGUN LUKE hit the gate at the start while breaking awkwardly, shifted off the inside racing off the second flight in the opening stages, continued four wide through the turn, angled six wide entering upper stretch to gain some position but made no impression on the leaders. CITOYEN STYLE joined the pace three deep between from the outset, pressed the issue between foes on the turn and emptied out in upper stretch. GIBBY'S TORNADO went up to dispute the pace between foes racing into the turn but was through after a half. FLYING ACT, urged to contend with the first flight along the inside from the break, dueled for command racing through the turn and gave way. FLAMING HEAT joined the pace four wide in early stages, pressed the issue three deep racing through the turn and emptied out in upper stretch.
