Footnotes

MINNIE SUNSHINE was settled in hand off the second flight a bit off the inside in the opening stages, made steady progress entering the turn, split foes midway through the bend while moving to striking distance after six furlongs, shifted out three deep while moving to command in upper stretch and made the balance of the pace under firm encouragement. TRIGGER FISH LANE ducked inwards at the start, was reserved well off the second flight while working her way to the inside, advanced to contention racing near the rail on the turn, came out in upper stretch to challenge three deep, couldn't gain terms with the winner but proved clearly second best. DO THE TIGER tracked the pacesetter from just out of striking distance under some reserve while angling to the inside in early stages, advanced along the rail on the turn to close the gap nearing upper stretch, disputed the issue between foes into the lane but lacked the needed final bid while continuing well enough to prevail for a share. TRIBECKY pulled her way clear to open a substantial margin after the opening quarter while shifting nearer the inside, held sway while maintaining that advantage to upper stretch but failed to sustain her momentum once headed leaving the three sixteenths marker. SHESA TOUGH KITTY shifted off the inside tracking the pacesetter from just out of striking distance while racing as part of the second flight in the opening half but quickly emptied out racing through the turn. FLASH GOLDEN shied inwards avoiding TRIGGER FISH LANE at the start, was guided to the outside to track the pace off the second flight in the opening half but never mounted a serious challenge. SHAQUITA trailed the field after the opening furlong, was soon outdistanced, then walked off the course under her own power.
