**Footnotes**

RIVRAV broke inwards making some light contact with WATTS FERRY at the break, was urged between foes to secure a forward placing racing just off the pacesetter in the opening quarter, stalked that foe in hand racing through the bend, lost some position to that rival in upper stretch but prevailed in time when responding in late stages to energetic handling. AMAZING BUD broke sharply, shifted to the rail dictating the pace on a narrow margin while setting a measured tempo racing into the bend, was urged to gain a clear advantage nearing midstretch and just failed to put the winner away. ROMAN A CLEF, held up off the second flight near the inside racing to the turn, angled out four wide leaving the midway point of the bend to advance on the leaders, then continued in that path through the stretch to close the gap and gain a share in the closing stages. WATTS FERRY, bumped at the start, was righted to track the pacesetter along the rail as part of the second flight racing into the turn, shifted off the inside in upper stretch and continued willingly to late stages while being outfinished for a share. WARLOCK WARRIOR raced unhurried off the second flight while off the inside racing to the turn, swung out five wide in upper stretch and continued in that path to the end while making an even effort. INDIAN TALK, caught four wide in early stages gaining a position in the second flight, tracked the leaders three deep racing through the bend and gave way entering upper stretch. NO MORE TALKIN tracked the pace between foes in the second flight racing to the bend but dropped out of contention midway through the turn. GREAT BAM settled well off the leaders while angling to the inside in early stages and never mounted a serious challenge.
