**Footnotes**

MASSIVE EXPLOSION, brushed in the opening stages, gained a narrow advantage dictating the pace a bit off the inside under light rating, continued with a steady response to extend the advantage racing into upper stretch and held sway on a commanding margin through late stages under pressure. PLUNDER tracked the pacesetter outside rivals in the second flight in the opening stages, continued with a steady bid into upper stretch but couldn't match terms with the winner late while holding well for second. IOLANDA'S PERFECT drifted out just after the start brushing the eventual winner, was rated in hand near the inside tracking off the second flight early, switched out three deep racing through upper stretch and continued with an even effort to earn a share. RADIANT DAY angled to the inside early while tracking off the second flight racing into the bend, then switched out four wide entering the lane to gain some position while making no real impression. REIGNING CATFISH reserved in last to the turn, swung out five wide racing into the stretch but never seriously menaced. BADGER BAY tracked just off the pacesetter inside rivals in the second flight racing into the turn and steadily faded into upper stretch. EL GINGER was never a factor.
