SOMETHING WICKED raced near the middle of the field, came out four wide for the drive and rallied but could not get by the winner. RAPIDRUNSTHERIVER vied for the lead inside and held on gamely in the drive. RUSTY JO raced near the middle of the field and made a bid on the turn but faltered. ROYAL BLESSING improved her position in the drive. LIKELY BALLET was never a factor. VEILED ROSE was close up early and weakened. MATTINA was always outrun. NAPERVILLE broke in the air and was never close. WILD WOMAN contested the pace just outside and tired.
