COPPER FOREST switched outside the pacesetter while moving to terms with that foe racing into the first turn, attended that rival's pace under rating to the second bend, responded when roused nearing the furlong marker to and held sway to the end under firm right handed encouragement. YEP, reserved in hand racing three deep behind the second flight to the far turn, switched out four or five deep in upper stretch and made solid progress late to prove best of the others. SUPAH SOUP was guided to the rail in the opening stages to track the leaders in second flight, altered course around a drifting rival nearing the furlong marker while making a brief bid, couldn't match terms with the top pair and just held for a share. FOUR TO GO was settled just off the inside in the opening half, shifted out nearing upper stretch to split foes four wide racing through the stretch and was just outfinished for a share. ALABAMA GOLD was urged to the lead while angling to the inside, dictated the pace on a narrow margin into the far turn, drifted in when failing to match the winner's bid nearing the furlong marker and quickly gave way. JACKS AGAIN, reserved along the rail in the opening half, saved ground to upper stretch, then raced in close quarters through the last furlong while failing to gain striking position. LITTLE FEAT was settled off the second flight along the inside racing to the far turn and couldn't produce the needed closing bid. BUDDY'S BID, forwardly placed from the outset racing three deep into the first turn, continued in that path racing as part of the second flight to the second bend, made a brief bid on the far turn and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. COMELATELEAVEARLY, a bit unruly in the gate, tracked the pace between foes in second flight to the far turn and gave way entering upper stretch.
