Footnotes

MILES AND MILES was rated just out of striking distance three deep in the opening stages, made a steady advance to close the gap on the pacesetter leaving the midway point of the turn, took over leaving the furlong marker and drew away under firm encouragement. LIGHTHOUSE JUDGE pulled his way to the lead while angling to the inside in the opening stages, dictated the pace on a clear margin into the bend, couldn't contain the winner's bid but held well for the place. JUDITH'S LAKE was settled off the inside in the opening stages, swung out on the turn to race five wide into upper stretch and finished evenly. HOT ROLSTON tracked the leaders unhurried off the inside early, angled inwards on the turn, split foes racing into upper stretch and finished evenly. TEXAS HEDGE, reserved off the inside in the opening five furlongs, displayed some belated interest between foes. MINING FOR SILVER tracked the leaders racing off the second flight while three and four wide racing into the turn but offered no rally. PEARL EXPRESS reared at the start, recovered briefly angling inside to track just off the leaders in the opening half but steadily faded nearing the lane. PRINCETON HILLS was roused to secure a forward placing while switching outside the pacesetter, couldn't gain terms with that foe and emptied out after six furlongs.
