Footnotes

RULER OF THE COURT was held up just off the pacesetter leading the second flight between foes to the backstretch, made a steady advance to gain terms with that foe leaving the far turn and prevailed in late stages under firm encouragement. ENGINE ROOM sped clear along the inside racing to the first turn, dictated the pace to upper stretch, resisted the winner's challenge but came up second best. FIRE CLOUD broke outwards bumping SEGURO, was righted to track just off the pacesetter while racing in tight quarters into the first turn, saved ground to upper stretch, then shifted off the inside in late stages to close the gap on the top pair. JAYBIRD'S MIRACLE was settled off the inside in the opening half, swung four wide racing into upper stretch and continued with a mild bid. CANNON'S CALL angled to the inside early gaining position in the second flight, shifted out to make a brief bid between foes leaving the second bend but had no final response. ALOT OF HONEY, reserved along the inside from behind the second flight, momentarily awaited an opening racing through the far turn, continued along the rail into the stretch but had no final response. SHELTOWEE was settled outside foes in the opening half, was fanned five wide into upper stretch but made no impression on the leaders. SMARTY MOUTH tracked the pace outside foes in second flight, was caught four wide on the far turn making a brief bid but steadily faded in the drive. SHARP TRICK was settled along the inside in the opening half, swung out six wide racing into upper stretch but offered no rally. PARK BOYS tracked the leaders racing three wide in second flight to the backstretch, made a brief bid between foes entering the far turn but flattened out entering upper stretch. SEGURO, bumped, then pinched back at the start, never menaced thereafter.
