Footnotes

CAN'T STOP RAVIN broke sharply, then was urged clear racing a bit off the inside in early stages, angled inwards entering the bend, turned back a challenge from DON'T RUSH JUSTICE entering upper stretch under steady prompting and was taken in hand in late stages once the issue was decided. The latter, a bit restless in the gate prior to the start, chased the pacesetter into the turn while shifting outside that foe, drew on terms after three furlongs but couldn't match the winner in the final quarter. DANCING LEAF tracked the leaders unhurried between foes from just out of striking distance early, was carried out a bit by KELA'S HEAT while being brushed by that foe leaving the turn, but steadily improved his position while shifting outside foes racing into the stretch. SKIPPY DUDE, shuffled back out of tight quarters soon after the break, settled into stride, angled out five wide in upper stretch while gaining some position but made no impression on the leaders. KELA'S HEAT tracked the leaders along the rail in early stages, made a brief bid midway through the bend while shifting out brushing DANCING LEAF leaving the bend but steadily faded entering upper stretch. BIG BULL was a brief factor three wide in the second flight but emptied out quickly on the turn.
