**Footnotes**

RANSOM ZIP, off a step behind the first flight, was hustled between foes to gain terms with the leaders in the opening furlong, edged away to gain a narrow advantage nearing the half mile marker while angling to the inside, held her margin racing into upper stretch and was kept to steady pressure to maintain her advantage to the end. JUDY MY DARLING, reserved a bit off the inside in the last flight in the opening stages, saved ground on the turn while gradually drawing into contention, shifted out to split foes near the inside in upper stretch and continued with a steady bid to the end to close the gap and prevail for place honors. SWEET CHI TOWN gained a position just off the second flight along the rail in early stages, shifted outside a tiring foe leaving the turn, switched back to the rail drawing into striking distance in upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick while prevailing for a share. COUNTRY CAUCUS tracked off the second flight between foes while under light rating early, made steady progress on the turn to split foes three deep entering upper stretch and continued to make mild progress to the end. INDIAN CHARLIZE, caught five wide in early stages while being urged to prompt the pace outside foes, angled inwards entering the bend to press the issue into upper stretch but gave way leaving the furlong marker. SHARE THE JOY tracked the leaders three deep off the second flight in early stages, was caught four wide racing through the turn while being urged to brief contention but lacked the needed final bid. MORKISSEFORMONKEY angled to the rail while being urged to a forward placing, tracked just off the leaders saving ground on the turn but steadily faded from contention nearing upper stretch. A. J.'S BEAUTY was settled into stride outside foes in early stages and never mounted a serious threat. KITTY COVENANT, urged to terms with the first flight three deep between foes in the opening stages, chased the leaders in that path into the turn and emptied out early.
