Footnotes

KING ROOTIN TOOTIN broke readily, moved to the fore outside a rival racing through the first turn, dictated the pace on a clear margin to the second bend, turned back several challenges to forge clear in upper stretch and widened his advantage to the end under steady pressure. PESO, forwardly placed along the rail racing to the backstretch, stalked just off the pacesetter inside a rival to the second bend, shifted out nearing upper stretch to force the issue but soon proved no match. FIRE CLOUD, reserved outside a rival in the last flight racing to the far turn, shifted out to split foes three deep leaving the second bend and continued well enough to gain a share. YUKAN DO IT TOO tracked off the second flight while angling nearer the inside in the opening stages, shifted outside foes while being urged to contention after a half, was caught, four, then three wide racing through the far turn but lacked the needed final bid. GRAZIE settled into stride along the inside racing to the backstretch but never gained contention. LETHAL bobbled at the start, was quickly righted to gain a position inside a rival in the second flight racing to the backstretch but steadily faded from contention entering the far turn. ANY GIVEN TIME, held up off the leaders soon after the break, moved to a position outside a rival in the second flight racing to the backstretch, lodged a brief bid entering the second bend but quickly emptied out.
