LATIKA LOVE saved ground early, angled out, made a steady advance and got up in the final strides. FORTHELONGHAUL chased the pace, opened up in the stretch but was caught at the wire. KEIAI TOKYO stumbled at the start, found her best stride late then finished well five wide. ROSE MEDALLION track the pacesetter off the rail, loomed boldly five wide and weakened. STIVERS SUPRISE bobbed at the break, pressed the pace and lacked a late response. RUN MAMA BEARE RUN set a slow pace, led to the stretch and faltered. LET IT RAIN was through early and never involved. UNDER THE RIM raced mid pack early then dropped back.
