PERFECT DRIFT was allowed to settle along the rail near the middle of the field, continued inside through the second turn, had to be steadied lacking room turning for home, split horses in upper stretch, rallied to the front and drew off while kept to his task. MAMBO TRAIN went up inside to set the pace under pressure, continued to show the way to the lane, dropped back a bit in the stretch then responded gamely to reclaim the place. HOME OF STARS raced off the rail near the middle of the field, was asked to pick it up turning for home then rallied belatedly for minor awards. BILLY ALLEN (IRE) raced close up off the rail, rallied to loom a threat in the stretch and weakened a bit late. FREEFOURINTERNET raced far back to the stretch then improved his position late. FANTASTICAT was void of speed while three wide and failed to reach a contending position. CRYPTOGRAPH pressed the pace of MAMBO TRAIN from off the rail but gave way in the drive.
