YANKEE INJUNUITY raced off the rail and rallied belatedly for a share. GOLETA SUMMIT bobbled at the start, lacked speed and improved his position. BIRDBIRDISTHEWORD also improved his position without threatening. GRAND CHEROKEE raced close up three wide and weakened. NERVE raced close up inside and gave way. HENRYJOHNAPPROVAL raced off the rail and gave way. I. B. PACKIN was always outrun. VOY POR UNO MAS pressed the pace from the inside and tired. ITS A MOON trailed throughout and was eased at the wire.
