**Footnotes**

SIG AND ZAG reserved off the inside from well out of striking distance early, circled foes six wide leaving the turn, continued with solid momentum moving to challenge the leaders leaving midstretch and took charge under steady encouragement. NEMO LANDING, reserved off the second flight along the rail in early stages, was shuffled a bit in tight quarters nearing the bend, saved ground to upper stretch, shifted out sharply leaving the three sixteenths marker bumping FAIR OAK, then came through close quarters racing through midstretch four deep to prevail for the place on the wire. RUN FOR SAMI, forwardly placed outside foes from the outset, tracked just off the leaders three deep, advanced to challenge in that path entering upper stretch, struck the front near the furlong marker but proved no match for the winner. WHODO, prominent between foes from the outset, dueled for command into upper stretch and weakened late. PLENTY O'JACK urged to the lead along the inside, dueled for command into upper stretch and weakened late. CAPTAIN WOOD, a bit outpaced early, gradually moved into contention shifting outside foes after a half, exchanged some contact with FAIR OAK racing in traffic near the quarter mile marker, but continued with interest outside foes to improve his position. YONA TORY tracked the pace between foes as part of the second flight, shifted out of close quarters leaving the bend but had no final response. PROUD EXPRESSION angled to the inside tracking just off the leaders, made a brief bid racing into upper stretch but flattened out in the last furlong. FAIR OAK tracked the leaders three wide behind the second flight, was carried out by NEMO LANDING leaving the three sixteenths mile marker while exchanging bumps with several rivals and soon faded. MY MAN JAY never seriously menaced. CALLINGTHEWEATHER was a brief factor four wide chasing the leaders into the turn, drifted out while racing in traffic leaving the quarter mile marker and gave way.
