DENOUN N DEVERB lacked speed five wide, rallied in the stretch then was no match for the winner while best of the others. SCARLETT WOLF raced close up three wide and put a head in front on the turn but could not last. SPARKS raced close up four wide and lacked a rally. GOFORTHEROSES lacked speed and improved her position. PINKSICLE also improved her position without threatening. ROSES FOR SANDY vied for the lead between horses and tired. YOU HEARD ME CART raced near the middle of the field and gave way. ASHORE PLAY gave way in the stretch. SEA OF GRASS was always outrun.
