MOCHA QUEEN raced just outside near the middle of the field, came five wide into the stretch, rallied and finished on even terms with HUMOROUS MISS. HUMOROUS MISS lacked speed, came out widest for the drive and rallied to dead heat for the win. STORMYBDANCING raced three wide near the middle of the field and gained belatedly. ECHO SPRING vied for the lead just outside but could not last. CHERYL'S MYTH saved ground near the middle of the field and lacked a serious rally. BAILAR lacked speed and improved her position. CHIC DANCER was very fractious in the gate, raced four wide and tired. VADAHILLA (FR) steadied into the first turn, raced close up and made a bid on the final turn but faltered in the drive. ANAPEST had early speed and tired. DOUBLE HALO was always outrun. (Race run in lane 3, rail at 0.)
