SINGER'S LEGACY vied for the lead between horses, drew off mid stretch and was clear while urged. CAPTAIN WOOD was bumped at the start, shuffled back and was taken up then found his best stride too late and got up for the place. WINNER'S STORY vied for the lead inside but failed to sustain the bid. STAR VECTOR had no speed, swung out widest in the turn then closed willingly. LOGAN'SSHOREBREEZE was bumped and broke outward, was placed forwardly but lacked a late response. HONEYMOON HOUSE had a rail trip and did not rally. SOLO CONCERTO vied for the lead off the rail then dropped back in the stretch. YUKON JAACK had no speed and raced widest in the stretch. HEZA GAMER pulled up on the backstretch.
