Footnotes

ROB YOUNG, never far back, tracked just off the pacesetter outside a rival to the backstretch, continued unhurried to the second bend, advanced readily to wrest command when called upon leaving the far turn and drew clear under steady encouragement. YUKAN B CLASSY TOO tracked just off the second flight in the opening half, advanced to challenge three deep racing through the far turn, couldn't gain terms with the winner but proved best of the others. BLUE CANOE moved to the fore inside foes racing into the first turn, dictated the pace into the far turn but gave way in upper stretch when failing to contain the winner's bid. CHIEF CHICAGO, forwardly placed between foes in the opening stages, tracked just off the leaders along the inside on the backstretch but lacked the needed closing response. BOOYA MOON was settled near the inside in the opening stages but never mounted a serious challenge. TIO CHENCHO hopped at the start, saved ground to the backstretch racing just out of striking distance but dropped out of contention leaving the far turn.
