Footnotes

THIRD CHANCE, urged to dispute the pace along the rail from the outset, shook clear midway through the turn and steadily widened her advantage while being kept to steady pressure. DR. DIAMONDS PRIZE bobbled at the start, was righted to gain a position outside a rival racing just out of striking distance in the opening stages, shifted out three deep nearing upper stretch while gaining some position and secured place honors late while never menacing the winner. SPANISH AMBASSADOR settled into stride outside a rival in the opening stages, gained some position while angling out four wide racing into upper stretch and finished well enough to earn a share. SHES GOT TO RUN was settled in hand while angling to the inside in the opening stages, shifted out entering upper stretch while being roused to advance, shifted in and out in traffic nearing the furlong marker but continued to improve her placing. CHICK FIGHT came under pressure early along the inside pursuing the leaders racing into the turn but never gained striking distance. MALAWI angled inwards while gaining terms with a rival on the pace, prompted that foe racing into the turn and gave way just before completing a half mile. CITYRAP, shuffled a bit in close quarters at the break, recovered to gain a tracking position just off the leaders racing to the turn but emptied out after three furlongs.
