SHE'S REALLY COOL set the pace from off the rail and drew off under urging. TEE WEE lacked speed, angled out five wide for the drive and rallied for the place while no match for the winner. BETTER BUTTER raced near the middle of the field, came four wide into the stretch and rallied but could not reach the winner and lost the place late. MACKINAW ISLAND raced close up off the rail and weakened. GROOVIN P raced four wide and was through early. SILKY SILHOUETTE lacked speed and improved his position. TINY KISSES made a bid on the turn but faltered. LIGHT OF FAITH was always outrun. JOHNNY'S CHANCE was also outrun. AFTERNOON KRYSTAL raced close up inside and tired.
